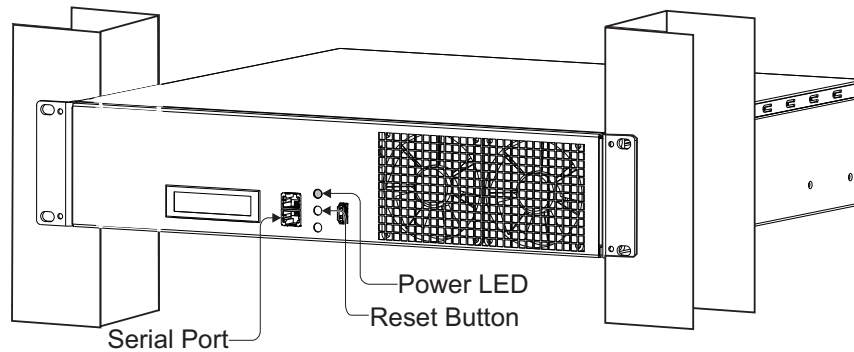

Install rack-mounting hardware on TMP6402 and install on equipment rack

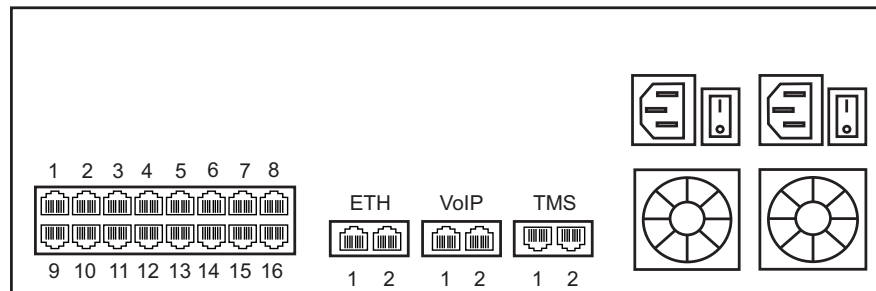

C) Connect TMS ports to TMS1600, if applicable (ports labelled TMS-1&2).



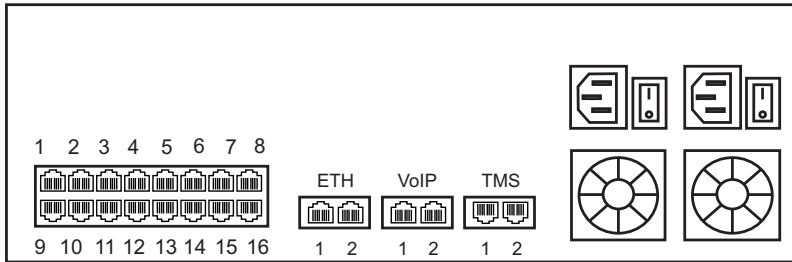

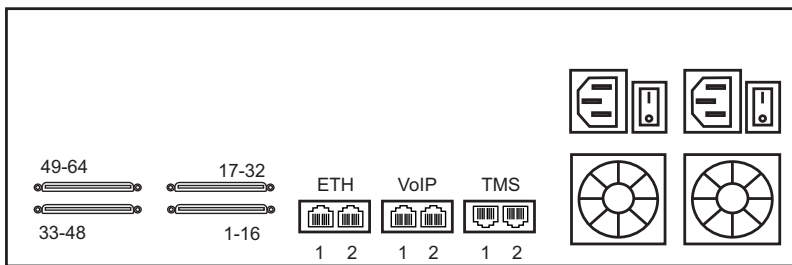
Connect to PSTN Network, using one of the following options:

- Optical Interface (OC3/STM-1)

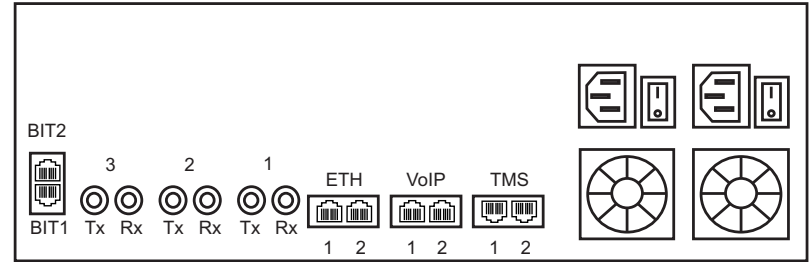

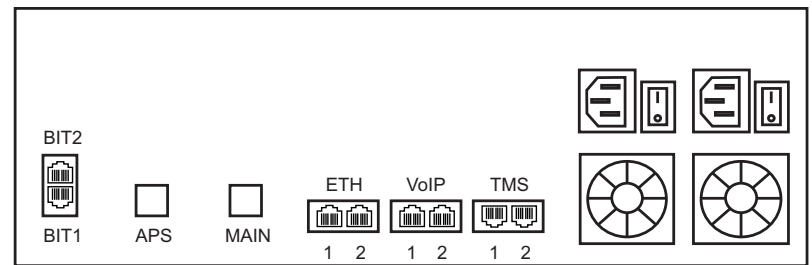
SCSI

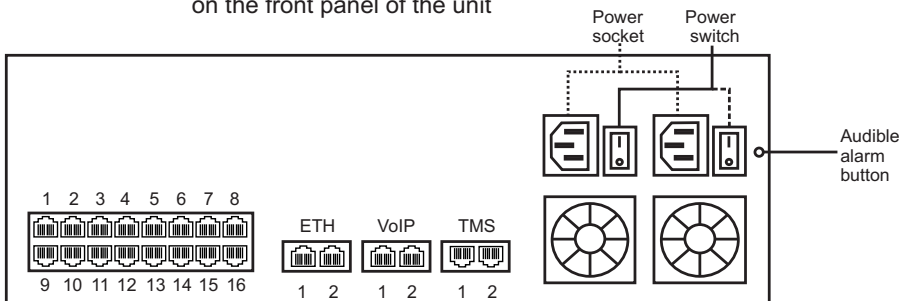

- A) Connect to two independent power sources (if only one power source is used, press the green button at the rear of the unit to disable the audible alarm).
- B) Turn on power by pressing the Reset Button on the front panel of the unit
- C) Verify Power LED = Solid Green (Refer to Panel 3)

Connect the TMP6402 serial port to your PC. (Refer to panel 3)
(If required, use the DB9 to RJ-45 Adapter.)

Using a serial terminal, configure the IP address and gateway.
Enter the following command:

- Type `set_boot`
